A typical latent print case averages about 10-15 hours of work (not including testimony and trial preparation). A 33% retainer of estimated hours (e.g. 5 hours) is required prior to commencing work. This retainer is waived for court appointed/funded attorneys (prosecutors, public defenders, appellate review) if an engagement agreement is procured prior to commencing work.
